## Ontario, Canada Marriages, 1801-1928



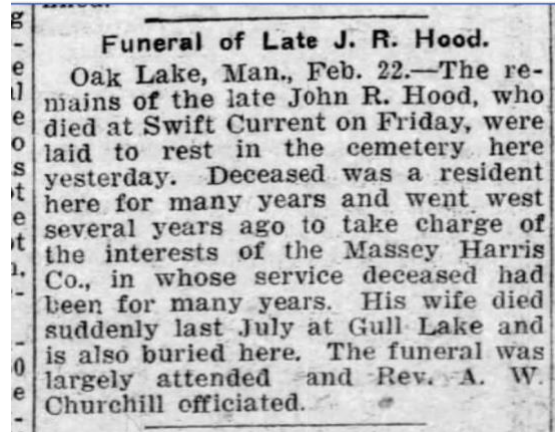
