Interment will be in Lake Nelson Memorial Park, New Market.</b></div><div><p>Mr. Emery died of a heart attack Tuesday night in Muhlenberg Hospital, Plainfield, shortly after admittance. He was 65 years old and was born on July 5, 1888, in Warren county. A temple maker by occupation, he was last employed as a loftsmen at Brooklyn Navy Yard. He retired in 1946. Mr. Emery belonged to Good Will Council 32, a Jr. O. U. A. M. of New Brunswick.</p></div></div></div></div>
