

Then Manager Kiernan sent Joe Golden, the local amateur twirler against the up-river aggregation and not only did Golden break their winning streak but gave them the soundest thrashing they have got all season. In the seven inning contest he got an 8-0 decision and allowed but three very scratchy hits. That Golden's mastery was complete is shown by the fact that the first scratch hit scored against him materialized in the fifth inning. The local City league association, through Umpire Finnell, presented Golden and Demoe, the local boy playing short-stop for Taunton, with bright new gloves, amid the plaudits of many admirers</p>
