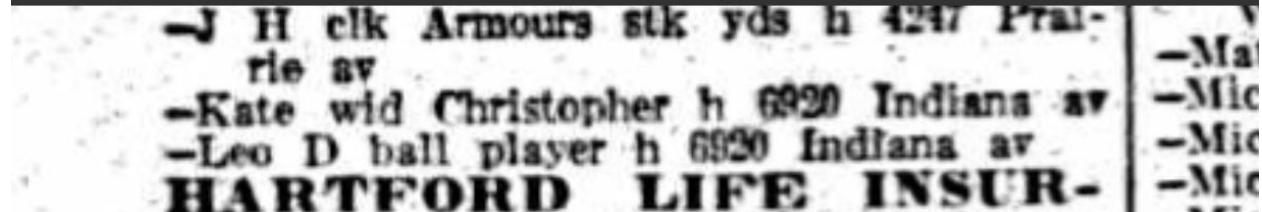

When the Washington team of the American league played Callahan's Logan Squares here two years ago the Senators were shy a third baseman and Hartford went in and held down the bag like a veteran.

Callahan was about to try out Hartford at third base for his fast team this season when Morrow came along and grabbed the hard hitting and speedy South Side lad.
