Goldrick is playing in the outlaw Federal League under an assumed name. He is liable to expulsion by the National Association and is already under suspension for failing to report to Ottawa. Together with Goldrick, is Von Hopper, the Syracuse boy, who caught for Ottawa last season. Hopper, who shared the back-stopping of the first Ottawa Canadian league club with Red Rowe in 1912, has signed to play with Amby McConnell's Utica team in the N. Y. State league. Hopper belonged to Fort Wayne while here, and when recalled in 1913 had a dispute over salary, and jumped to the Indianapolis Federals. He was suspended by Fort Wayne, and, failing to hold a job with the Feds., has been out of the game ever since.</p>
