Harley, formerly of Dayton; outfielder Wellmund, formerly of Syracuse, and third baseman W. Brentzen, a local semi-pro.

Leo McGraw, also of this city, who was a member of the Des Moines club, and who has received a trial with the Chicago White Sox, may also join "Cy's" club. McGraw is now trying to get his release from Des Moines.

In the seventh round Love of the Gunthers was touched for three hits in a row. With the bases full Catcher Daly dropped two good throws to the home plate, runners scoring each time. A single by Eberle brought the count to 5.

Love played a good game outside of his bad round, when poor support completed his downfall. He stuck to the finish and struck out eight men without giving a pass. Score:
