Meets Notre Dame in Double-Header at South Bend.

CRAWFORDSVILLE, Ind., April 11.—The Wabash College squad will depart for South Bend tomorrow where it will play two games with Notre Dame. The scarlet is sadly lacking in practice, but hopes to get an even break with the Catholics. The decision of "Slim" Myers to enter professional baseball is a serious blow to the team, as he easily was the strongest pitcher. Hazel Lambert and Ben Watt probably will do the twirling in the games at South Bend. The other positions will be filled as follows: Huffine, catch; Howard, first base; Capt. Williams, second base; Hill, shortstop; K. Lambert, third base; Staggs, left field; Sweet, center field; Glover, right field. Coach Harper may make some changes in his lineup, as the team has not had enough outdoor practice to enable him to get a line on all of the candidates.

Although Manager Harry Eller has already compiled for the college a schedule of games for the coming season, the present outlook is ominous. Capt. Elliott, the former Sheridan star, has been chosen to lead the Little Giants on the gridiron this season. He is one of the best players in school. Another good man is Skeet Lambert, brother of "Pig" Lambert, who is one of the best athletes that Wabash has ever turned out.
There are many other players of ability on whom it was counted to materially strengthen the team this season. An early call will be issued for candidates.
