SPURNED, SLAYS
WIFE AND SELF

Former Ball Player Leaves
His Two Babies
Orphans.

James McDonough, former Federal league baseball player, shot and killed his wife and himself last night at 7:30 o'clock in the vestibule of an apartment building at 4250 Vincennes avenue, following his failure to bring about a reconciliation. Mrs. McDonough was on her way home to 468 East Forty-third street.

It was said McDonough was soon to be called in the draft and had been vainly endeavoring to have his wife return to him or sign his exemption. She had refused both.

The two children of the McDonoughs, Dolores, 3 years old, and Joseph, 18 months old, were waiting for
