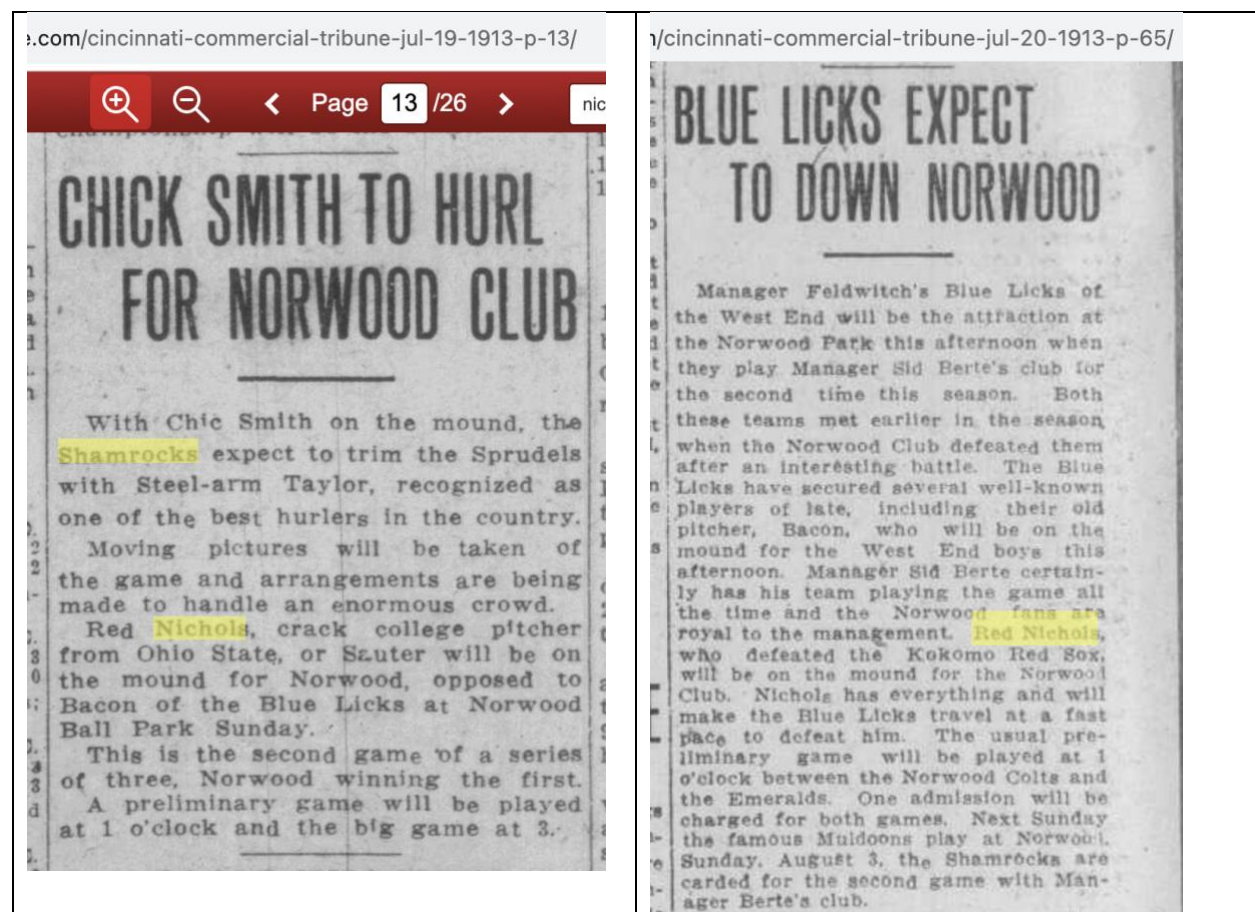

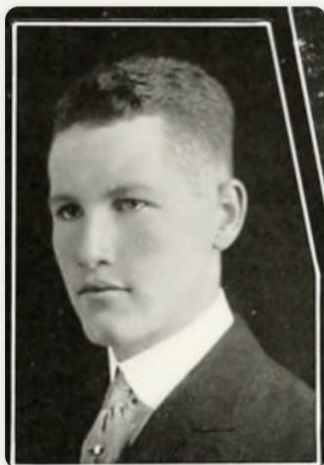

# Raymond Nichols Rites On Saturday

Raymond B. Nichols, a veteran technical engineer in Goodyear Tire & Rubber Co.'s Research and Development Department and a leader in Goodyear Heights Presbyterian Church, died Wednesday.

He was 68 and lived at 1588 Hillside ter.

Mr. Nichols was born in Loveland, O., and came to Akron and Goodyear 41 years ago, shortly after graduation from Purdue University.

He was a former president of the congregation at his church and also was a trustee and deacon.
