One of the best pinch hitters in the Virginia League is Joe Reggy, shortstop on the Danville team. He also played in several independent leagues in and around Cincinnati, and in 1903 played with Manager Ed Ransick on the Charleston (W. Va.) team. The following year he played in the Alabama-Tennessee League on the Huntsville (Ala.) team. In 1905 he was with the Norwood Club in the Saturday Afternoon League, of Cincinnati, playing second base. He came here last season, and has been doing clever work both with the bat and in the infield.

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If it was necessary for any new town in a minor league to secure an entire team Cincinnati could furnish the following bunch at once: Nippert and O'Connor, c.; Joe Doyle, 1b.; Joe Reggy, ss.; Cy Young, 2b.; Dan Davis, 3b.; Ollie Chapman, cf.; Buz Steele, lf.; Brownie McLain, rf.; Cefala, O'Donnell and Earl Golden, p.
