Southern Michigan League team last year, and he made a good record. He and Graham are the only two southpaws among Manager Carr's seventeen pitchers, and since Dave Schreiber and Hil Kuepper have been turned adrift it is proof that Carr has a great deal of confidence in Reynolds's ability.

Reynolds, Spencer and Hardgrove are the three young pitchers that will be taken on the training trip. The other pitchers are Lindaman, Graham, Theilman, Orth, Slagle, McCarthy and Duggan. The players who will be in the party that leaves St. Louis are Chadbourne, Bowerman, Lemon, Wakefield, Mowe, Hopke, Callahan, Haynes, Lewis, Murch, Howley, A. E. Spencer, Milligan, Delahanty, Williams, Manager Carr and Otto Weickman, trainer. The squad will leave Waco on the return trip on Sunday, March 27, and arrive at Indianapolis on March 30. The exhibition series with the Philadelphia athletics will open on April 1.
