Joseph J. Zoellers familiarly known as "o'd reliable" and who has taken such good care of the left garden for the past three seasons is a native of St. Louis and like so many bright stars of the base ball firmament gained his first knowledge of the game on the lots of the Mound City. Joe has played with most of the semi-professional teams of St. Louis and vicinity and was a valued member of the famous "Belleville-Clark's team," in the late nineties, an organization universally admitted the strongest semi-professional team in the west and who had the honor of defeating the big league teams of St. Louis, Louisville and Cincinnati in suc-

cession. His record with the Springfield team is too well known to need recounting. Sufficient to say whenever a ball goes sailing out towards left field some enthusiastic fan yells "it's in a well" and it's dollars to doughnuts that it safely reposes in Joe's mitt.
