John Paul Jones, former major league pitcher, minor league manager, and promoter of semi-pro baseball in North Louisiana, turned in the names of five players in an effort to help the local baseball situation. Jones says all the players are "promising" and classes John Corcoran, a second baseman, as being ready for Texas league ball.

In addition to Corcoran, whose home is in St. Louis, Mo., Jones has arranged for Alfred Bernard of Quitman, a third baseman; Tom McPhal, Colfax, a pitcher; Mike Smith, south-paw hurler, formerly with L.S.U., and Homer Hazel, a young outfielder, of Mississippi, to join the Sports. All have played independent and league ball in this section.

"Corcoran is a good second baseman," Jones said. "He is 19 years old, weighs 180 pounds, is about five feet ten inches tall. Two years ago he was with a semi-pro team in Waco. He played in 37 games for El Dorado and batted more than 300. He spent one year with the Hodge semi-pro team and was the sensation of that league.
