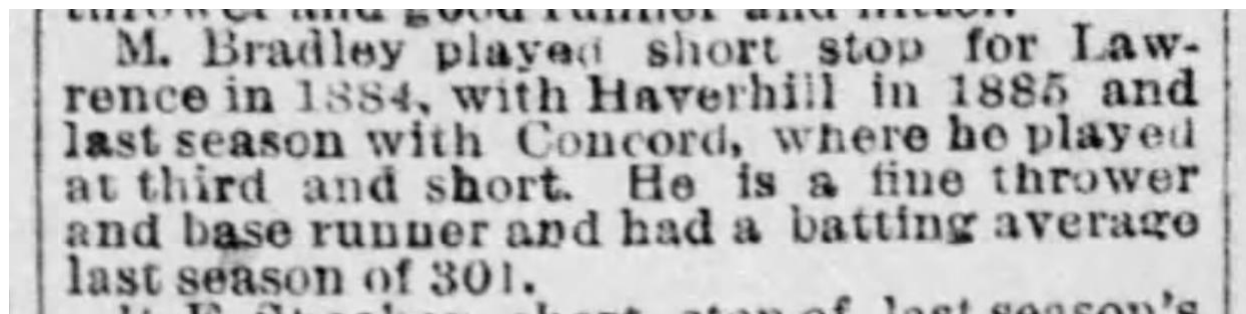

THE LATEST ADDITION.

Bradley, of the New England League, Signs With the Kansas City Club.

By telegraph this morning Mr. E. E. Menges signed H. Bradley, of the New England league. Bradley has the reputation of being one of the best fielders in the Eastern League, and is an especially strong batter. He will probably play in the center garden. Campan, the best left fielder in the New Orleans club, is being eagerly sought after by Manager Manning, and has about consented to place his signature to a Kansas City contract. Campan has been in demand, more so than any fielder on the market, and both Brooklyn and Cincinnati have offered large salaries for a year's service.

The signing of Campan by Manager Manning left but one position in the Kansas City nine to fill, that of right field. After duly considering the matter Messrs. Menges and Manning have decided that they will retain Hassamaer, the right fielder of this season's team. Hassamaer is young, and Manager Manning says he has a few points yet to learn in the base ball business, but adds that he is an apt scholar. The early part of this season Hassamaer handled the bat with ease, and seldom stood the plate without scoring a hit. As the season advanced, however, Hassamaer grew weaker, and in the last game some unkind spectator was heard to cry out "Hass couldn't hit a basket." The young fielder says he thinks that by next year he will get back into his old habit of hitting the ball, and as he scarcely knows how to make an error in the field, he is considered a valuable man.

The club is now complete, and professional ballists say that it is the strongest in the new league. Here are the names of the players:

Manager Manning will leave for California this week, where he will join McCarty and Johnson on the Los Angeles team, playing there during the entire winter. While on the coast Manning will sign an additional pitcher and a catcher for the Kansas City club.

Base Ball Gossip.

A mistaken impression prevails that the Bradley recently signed by Kansas City is Nick Bradley of Southern league fame. This is wrong, as it is Michael Bradley of the Lawrence, Mass., club who will play here. What they think of him in New England is shown by the following extract from a Lawrence letter in the Sporting Life: "That foxy old veteran, good natured Tim Murnan, slipped out here and carried away Mike Bradley's signature attached to a Kansas City contract. Lord Timothy, you secured a jewel, one of the finest general players in the New England league, a good out or in fielder, batter, fast runner, and his habits are such as to make him an ornament to any club." Dalch Johnson yesterday received a handsome

Lowell Makes an Acquisition.
 LOWELL, March 31.—The Lowell base ball management has accepted the terms, and signed Michael J. Bradley, second baseman formerly of the Worcesters and the Kansas City team. The new acquisition is met with great enthusiasm here, as Bradley has been in the past one of the favorites of Lowell base ball cranks. His position being second base, settles the question as to whether Billy Higgins will be signed, the latter having been asked for his terms.

The corps of umpires of the New England league staff for next season is complete. The staff is the strongest ever secured, and consists of Thomas H. Connolly of Natick, Michael H. Bradley of Lawrence, John T. Hunt of Providence, and Stephen J. Kelley of Lewiston. E. G. Webster of Portland is first on the list of substitute umpires, and will receive the first regular appointment in case of vacancy.



He has been with Jess Burkett of the Worcester Club the past three years and under the fine guiding hand of Jesse has developed into a first-class first baseman.
