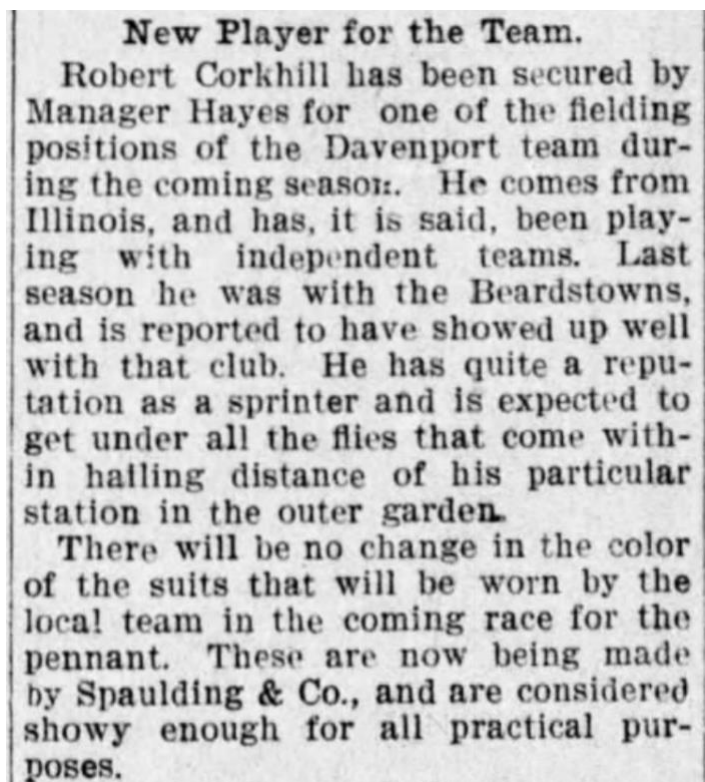

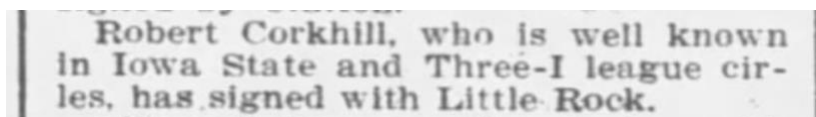

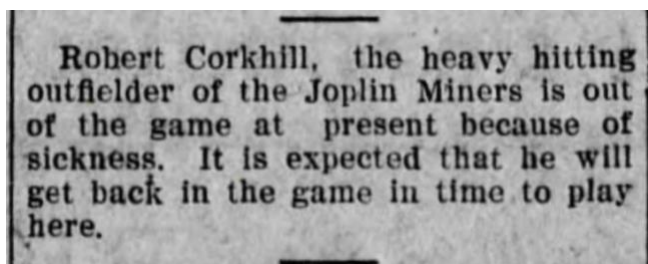

BATTLE CREEK, April 20.—Secretary French of the Battle Creek baseball association announced Wednesday evening that Infielder "Curly" Henderson had been sold to the Jackson, Miss., club of the Cotton States league. Henderson has played with the Crickets for the past three years and was accounted one of the most sensational short fielders in the league.

Outfielder Robert Corkhill, purchased by Battle Creek, from the Houston, Texas league team, reported to Manager Burke Wednesday morning. Last year he was one of the hardest hitting and best fielding outfielders in the Texas league.
