


James T. Deegan of 100 Francis Avenue, former professional baseball player, died suddenly Tuesday night at his home. Mr. Deegan played short



Hartford Courant August 9, 1886

The correspondent of the Daily Base Ball Gazette was incorrect when he said the Hartfords had fourteen men on their trip. Manager Daniels took eleven players, including Deegan, with him. Diven and Cramer did not go.

Hartford Courant April 23, 1887

The Amusement company do not feel that they can go into baseball this summer. The idea is therefore to let the Amusement company stay out and run a good amateur team with the addition of a professional battery. Among the local men who could be secured are Turner, catcher, an old league player; Jimmy Deegan, also a league player; Griswold, Redigan, George Bowers, Sheehan, Snow of Glastonbury, Stannard, Bob Smith, Riley, Gagal, Campbell, Blanchard and Brown. 
