ONE SIGNED, TWO RELEASED.

Manager Gooding has signed John Wiehe, of Cincinnati, who is said to be a fine player in either the in or out-field, as well as a hard hitter and daring base runner. He has released Jordan, catcher, and Shaw, shortstop. He did the square thing by them, and paid their fares back to Minneapolis. He reiterates his intention of strengthening the team in the weakest points, and the releasing of these two men is but part of the policy. Manager Gooding thinks that if Wiehe turns out to be a good in-fielder he will play him at third, and with Walsh at short, the infield will be one of the strongest in the league.
