This week he will get to work on the field, when something more definite can be seen. Parsons is being curiously watched by the critics, and is pronounced "a bird," but nothing but actual play will develop what he can do. Manager Gooding is very reticent about claiming anything for him, preferring to await the result of events. He has about every curve, shoot, rise and drop known in the box, but nothing can be told of his nerve, self-possession or command of the ball, which are everything in a game. He is modest and unassuming, which will recommend him to the cranks. Rehse, who is a Minneapolis amateur, comes out with a very speedy delivery and a good curve. He is large and strong, and looks as though he could stand a heavy strain and then come in and slug the ball.

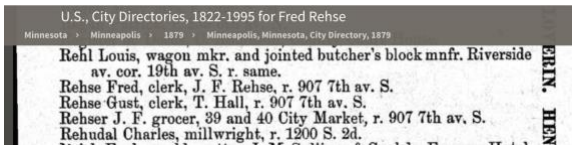
